



John "Jack" Casimir Gallas

February 8, 1932 - July 31, 2019

John "Jack" Casimir Gallas, 87, of Charlotte, NC, and formerly of Mt. Prospect, IL, died unexpectedly on Wednesday, July 31, 2019.

Born in Cook County, Illinois, on February 8, 1932, he was the son of Casimir and Lillian Gallas. Jack grew up in Chicago, served in the U.S. Air Force for four years, stationed in Guam during the Koran Conflict and worked as a computer programmer for Baxter Labs and many municipalities in the Chicagoland area. Jack loved to travel. He visited more than 99% of the counties in the United States and kept track of his progress on a map he proudly displayed in his family room.

He and Natalie retired to the Charlotte area in 1987 keeping busy with volunteer work at St. John Neumann Catholic Church, the Knights of Columbus chapter of the church, and gatherings with friends at local restaurants. He loved to tell a good joke -- and his timing was always spot on. In his younger years, he was also a stamp and coin saver and enjoyed collecting them. Most of all, though, Jack was a lover of people and the time spent with them.

He is survived by his wife of 55 years, Natalie; his children Sharon Meeker of Hoffman Estates, IL, and John Donahue of Charlotte; and a sister Marilyn Liden of Charlotte. Jack is further survived by numerous nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 AM on Thursday, August 8, at St John Neumann Catholic Church. Burial with military honors will follow at a later date at the VA National Cemetery in Salisbury, NC.
