Joyce Hartis O'Keefe, 81, of Charlotte, died May 23, 2021.

Born in Charlotte, NC, on March 9, 1940, Joyce was the daughter of Wilma and James Everett Hartis. She grew up there and graduated from high school. She then chose to serve in the United States Army and did so from April of 1958 to April of 1960. While stationed at Fort McClellan, Alabama, she met Mr. Raymond Dennis O'Keefe. They were married on November 12, 1960, after they were both honorably discharged from the Army. They moved to his homeplace of New Jersey where they resided several years before returning to Charlotte where they remained. They were married 56 years, and Raymond passed away in 2017.

Joyce lived a life of service. Not only serving her country in the military, she served those around her in many other ways. She volunteered at Crisis Ministries and practiced her faith with her church family at Our Lady of Assumption. A devout Catholic, she belonged to a Rosary making guild and made and donated Rosaries for many years. Wherever there was a need, she served in any way she could. Most of all, however, she loved to serve her family, and enjoyed caring for her husband and her home.

Joyce is survived by a daughter Eileen (husband Wade) Jarvis and two sons, Ray (wife Sonya) O'Keefe and David O'Keefe. She is further survived by a sister, Phyllis, a brother, Jim, five grandchildren, six great grandchildren, and numerous other relatives and friends. She was preceded in death by a brother, Jerry, and sons, Robert and Michael.
