Robert “Bob” Paul Clause, 84, of Fenton, Michigan, and recently of Matthews, North Carolina, died Saturday, March 14, 2020, at Atrium Health Main in Charlotte.

Bob was born in Wayne County, Michigan, on August 25, 1935, the oldest of five children born to Joseph and Helen Cotter Clause. Bob spent time serving his country as a member of the National Guard before going to work for General Motors. He worked there as an engineer before he ultimately retired from GM. Bob’s life was not all about work, however, and he was a lifelong fan of the Detroit Red Wings and the Detroit Tigers. In fact, one of his most cherished possessions to this day was his Detroit Red Wings pillow that was knit for him by his sister, Lois.

He took residence at the Cadence Senior Living Facility and quickly became part of their family while also becoming much closer to his daughter-in-law’s family as well. His smile, laughter and gentle demeanor made him loved by all and he will most assuredly be missed even by those who knew him but those four short months.

Bob is survived by his son, Chris; his daughter-in-law, Silvana; his grandchildren: Chelsea Mayers (husband Bryan) of Chapin, SC, Cyrena Clause of Charlotte, Emily Parks of Matthews and Isabella Parks of Matthews; his two great grandchildren: Liam Loeffler and Noah Mayers; and the mother of his son, Roberta Meisel of Fenton, Michigan. He is further survived by numerous other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his four siblings and his parents.


