Albert Lee Rabon, 71, of Mint Hill, went to his heavenly home on May 26, 2014.

Al was born on August 25, 1942, in Granite Quarry, North Carolina, the son of Jethro Clement "J.C." Rabon and Verla Maye "Bobbie" Helms. On May 26, 1963, he married Sharon Smith. He lived in Granite Quarry through 1963 at which time he moved to Charlotte where he has been a resident ever since. Al spent 40 years as a salesman for Carolina Controls and the last 28 years as a Pastor. His most recent congregation was Mission Tabernacle. Most of all, Al loved caring for his family and friends, and he will be sadly missed by all who knew him.
