Mr. Alexander "Al" Lee Grady Jr., 77, of Mint Hill, North Carolina, passed away on Saturday, December 5, 2015 with his family by his side at Novant Hospital in Matthews, North Carolina. Al was born in Morganton, NC on October 7, 1938 to Alexander Lee Grady Sr. and Myrtle White Grady. After graduating from Morganton High School in 1957, he joined the United States Air Force and was stationed in Thule, Greenland, El Paso, Texas and Savannah, Georgia. Upon leaving the Air Force in 1961, he attended Charlotte Business College. He later met and married his beloved wife of 51 years Lynn Newton. Al was the successful business owner of Alexander's Office Systems, Inc. in Mint Hill, NC, retiring in 1993. He is survived by his loving wife Lynn, and children, Eric, Ragan, Ryan (and wife Elicia), John and Alex. Surviving grandchildren are Brooke, Lauren, and Gabriel Grady, Adam and Faith Ryoti.
