



## Barbara Jane Campbell

Barbara Jane Pangle Campbell, 83, of Albemarle, NC, and formerly of Charlotte, died Saturday, May 13, 2023, at the Spring Arbor of Albemarle.

Barbara was born in Mecklenburg County on April 10, 1940, the daughter of Paul and Lucille Springs Pangle. She grew up in Charlotte and graduated from West Mecklenburg High School in 1958. She went on to graduate from Presbyterian School of Nursing and the Pediatric Nurse Practitioner program at UNC Charlotte. Barbara loved children and spent 31 years in the Mecklenburg County Foster Care system taking care of the medical needs of foster children.

Another family Barbara was proud to call her own was her church family at Mulberry Presbyterian Church, where she had been a lifelong member. She sang in the Chancel Choir for many years and played the hand bells.

When not working, she loved to square dance, round dance and travel. For many years, she took part in the water aerobics program at the Dowd YMCA and later enjoyed Body & Soul Senior Fitness classes where she made many good friends. Barbara also enjoyed walking her neighborhood where she was a familiar site as she checked in on neighbors and friends during her daily

walks.

In 1997, she married Guy Campbell, a very kind and caring gentleman. Together they traveled to many parts of the United States and the world. It was with him that she loved to square dance as well.

And while Barbara made many friends throughout life, most important to her was her family. Using her nursing skills, she took care of several elderly family members. She was truly a caring and giving soul who will be missed by all who had the privilege of knowing and being loved by her.

Barbara is survived by her special grandson, Tyler (wife Elizabeth) Haney; a great grandson Austin Drane Haney; and a son-in-law, George Simpson. She is further survived by three nephews, many cousins and numerous other relatives and friends. She was preceded in death by her beloved daughter, Susan Harkey Simpson; her parents; a brother, Bill Pangle; her first husband and father of Susan, Bob Harkey; a special sister-in-law, Jean Harkey; and her beloved husband, Guy.

Visitation will take place on Thursday, May 18, 2023, from 6 to 8 pm at Mulberry Presbyterian Church, 5600 Tuckaseegee Road, Charlotte, NC 28208.
