Benjamin Culver Hedrick, 69, of Matthews passed away August 5th 2023.

Blessed with a natural athletic talent, Ben played football, earning a scholarship which he used to attend Davidson College, where he continued to play football while learning just enough to earn his degree in Psychology. Ben moved to the Charlotte/Matthews area where he had been a resident for over 40 years.

In addition to being blessed with athletic talent, Ben was blessed with an uncanny sense of humor and the ability to relate to people. Using these skills, he became a successful salesman in industrial equipment, working for Pande Controls, Mechanical Supply Company and Eastern. Ben was preceded in death by his parents.

One habit he soon developed was putting all his spare change in a jar, and when he had accumulated enough, he would go the local convenience store and buy a pizza, usually around 8 pm. When he came back, he would sit in our living room and with each bite of pizza he would express his delight both visually and vocally in an exaggerated fashion. If you new Ben very well, I am sure you are having no trouble visualizing this. There were 5 of us that roomed together in what was called the "White House", so Ben's eating performance was certainly designed to make us all envious of his enjoyment.
