Bennet August Magri Sr, 49, of Matthews, died unexpectedly April 9, 2018.

Ben, as he was commonly called, was born in Cleveland, Ohio, on February 7, 1969, the son of Joseph John and Marian Camma Magri. He went on to graduate from Ohio State with a degree in Agronomy. Most recently, he had been working for US Turf of Locust.

On November 18, 1995, he married Megan Dobbins, whom he met at Howl at the Moon in Cleveland. They were truly best friends who experienced all of the highs and lows of life together. An especially fond memory shared with his wife was celebrating their first St Patrick's Day kicking a 12 pack across the parking lot.

Ben enjoyed many things in life, with most of them centered around his three children. He will be sadly missed by all who knew him.
