Bernard Miller Jr, 66, of Charlotte, NC, died Saturday, May 7, 2022, at Novant Medical Center in Mint Hill, North Carolina.

Bernard was born in Baltimore, Maryland, on October 28, 1955, the son of Roland and Edith Kelly Miller. He grew up there and graduated from City College. Blessed with a talent to use his hands and enjoying the outdoors, Bernard set up his own landscaping and tree business in the 1980's. On May 10, 1984, he married the love of his life, Ms. Francine Smith, and would have celebrated 38 years this year. In 1992, they moved to North Carolina and in 1995, took up residency in Charlotte, where he has been since. Bernard went on to work as a machine operator for Merita Bakery. When not working, Bernard enjoyed work (if you knew him, you knew that as a workaholic, there was no such thing as not working). Most of all, he enjoyed the time spent with family and friends.

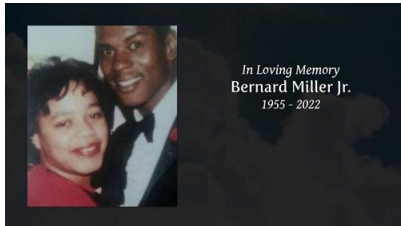

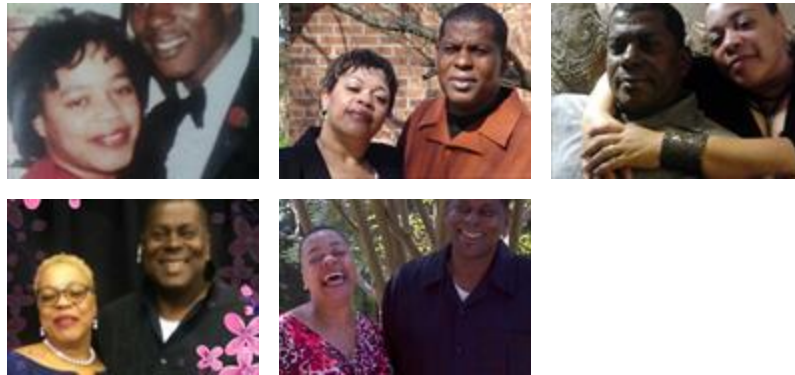
