There is a time and appointed place where each life reaches its zenith and after comes the setting of the sun. Mrs. Williams was the sixth of eight children born June 16, 1941, to the late Thomas and Sarah Owens in Latta, South Carolina. She was married for 52 years to the late Reverend, Retired LTC Alex Edward Williams of Aiken, South Carolina. He departed his life on May 19, 2015. She departed her life on April 12, 2021, after a brief stay in Sunrise Assisted Living Facility and at the Matthews Medical Center, where she demised in her sleep with her daughter Alexis and sister Faye present, each holding her hands.

She was baptized at age 5 and at the age of 12, she dedicated her life to Christ and joined Emmanuel A.M.E. Church. Throughout her various residences as a Military Officer and Pastor's wife, she served in different churches in the following positions: a Sunday School Teacher, Women's Missionary Society, Stewardess Board, Black History Month Planner, Director of Vacation Bible School, and Bible School Coordinator. Her latter church for several years was St. Mark Missionary Baptist Church in Aiken, SC. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Mrs. Williams consistently participated in live virtual services with the House of Hope in Atlanta, Georgia.

She graduated from C.A. Johnson High School; Bachelor of Arts Degree from Allen University; and, a Master's Degree from Troy University. She worked many years as a librarian in public and private schools from the elementary level to the college level. She retired from working in Aiken, South Carolina. She was a 60-year member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated, and volunteered for the Red Cross and as a Girl Scout Leader.

She was a member of the American Association of School Librarians. Her strong love for

books and reading was paramount in her life. She loved reading the Bible; and, donating them and other religious material to many. She was a devoted wife, a loving and caring mother to her children and grandmother to her five grandchildren. If you visited her at home, she was always proud to show you her books and cookbook collections. Just to mention, she was the outstanding senior recipient of the high school Betty Crocker Scholarship. She was a lovely majorette in high school and college.

As a devoted military wife, Mrs. Williams lived in a number of places including Monterey, CA; Columbia, SC; Ft. Leavenworth, KS; Seat Pleasant, MD; Ft. Benning, GA; and Columbus, GA. She most enjoyed her travels in the Orient when Col. Williams was stationed at Okinawa Island in Japan.

Mrs. Williams leaves to cherish her memories: her devoted daughter, Alexis Renee, of Stallings, NC. Her youngest son, Kyle (Chandra), of Johns Creek, GA. Her first-born son, Keith "Regi" was pre-deceased. Her five grandchildren: Kyia, Justin, Alex, Madison, and Brianna; Sisters: Sara Faye Hardy, Columbia, SC; Cora Lee Posey, Newark, NJ; Brothers: LaVern Owens, Lexington, NC; and Augustus Owens, Newport News, VA; a host of nieces, nephews; relatives; cousins; and special friends.

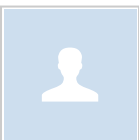
