



## Bobby Ray Williams

September 3, 1947 - May 1, 2014

Bobby Ray Williams, 66 of Charlotte, died at his home under hospice care on May 1, 2014.

Bobby Ray was born in Mecklenburg County on September 3, 1947, the son of James Williams and Thelma Alexander. On September 21, 1964, he answered his country's call to service and enlisted in the United States Army. Before his honorable discharge on November 24, 1967, he was awarded the National Defense Medal, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal with 3 Bronze Service Stars, Rifle Marksman, and the Combat Infantry Badge. Upon his return to civilian life, he went into publishing and worked for Knight Publishing, owner of The Charlotte Observer. He retired in 2009 after 40 years of service. On February 17, 2001, he married Trudy Tarleton. Bobby Ray was always about helping others take a bad situation and turn it into something good. His involvement with AA and Hope Haven impacted countless lives and he will be sadly missed as the advocate, mentor, and friend that he was to all in those programs. Most of all, he will be missed by his family and friends.

Bobby Ray is survived by his wife, Trudy; six children: Jennifer Williams, Chris Williams, Bobby Ray Williams, Catherine (husband Tony) Harris, Randy Tarleton, and Sonya Tarleton; four grandchildren: Michael Williams, Heather Tarleton, Holly Tarleton, and Cloe Riley; and three siblings: Helen Broome, Yvonne (husband Jim) Ewing, and Gloria (husband Raymond) Black. Bobby Ray is further survived by a numerous nieces, nephews, other relatives, and friends.
