Carol Simpson-Miller, 82, our spirited mother, grandmother, sister, aunt and wife, passed away peacefully in her sleep on Thursday, November 19, 2020. Carol was born on August 22, 1938, the daughter of the late Paul and Lucile Simpson. She was a proud and life-long resident of Charlotte, NC.

Carol was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Raymond "Ray" Miller. Carol and Ray were married for 54 years. In their life together they enjoyed taking road trips, loved playing pinochle and cribbage, slow dancing after dinner and spending quality time with their family and friends.

Throughout her life she embraced many hobbies and activities; singing with her siblings, learning the catechism, reading world history, cooking, playing Bingo, watching Jeopardy, playing games with her family, long-winded phone conversations with her loved ones, laughing at British TV, passing time on her front porch swing, playing in the rain and the flora and fauna of her Southern surroundings.

Above all, Carol loved her family fiercely. She was one of kind, smart, talented, witty, competitive and spunky. Her death leaves a void in the lives of all that knew her and she will be missed and loved forever.
