Constance “Connie” Elaine Homola, 64, of Monroe, died January 17, 2022, at Atrium Health Union in Monroe.

Connie was born in Philadelphia on March 8, 1957, the daughter of Clyde and Doris Mink Wills Jr. She grew up in Philadelphia, graduating from Ridley High School, Class of 1975. On July 29, 1983, she married Michael T. Homola in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. They lived in Philadelphia where all three of their sons were born before they moved to Monroe in 1995. Connie then went to work for the Union County Sheriff’s Department as a detention and court officer, positions she held until 2005. 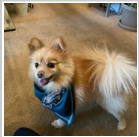
