



## Daniel Goldberg

November 23, 1930 - October 26, 2023

Daniel Goldberg, 92, of Charlotte, died Thursday, October 26, 2023, at The Haven in Highland Creek in Charlotte. Born on November 23, 1930, in Los Angeles; Daniel was the son of Nathan and Minnie Goldberg.

At age 17, Dan came to Messiah Jesus on July 31, 1948. He married Sarah Madeline Smith, September 6, 1956. Although Dan and Madeline had no children of their own, they had a loving niece, Stephanie, and a very special niece and nephew: Elasheva Crawford and Aaron Ariel Anderson.

Extended family includes a faithful sister-in-law Genive and brother-in-law Donald Underwood, along with other fond family members on Madeline's side. Dan and Madeline have many spiritual children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren.

Dan furthered his education at Moody Bible Institute, receiving a Pastor's Diploma, Goshen College with a B.A, a B.D, and Th.M from Northern Baptist Seminary, followed by a doctorate in theology (Th.D) from Grace Theological Seminary.

Dan has served as Pastor of several churches in the Midwest, taught as a Professor to college and seminary students from the east to west coast, conducted Israeli tours for college students, facilitated Bible, missionary, and

prophecy conferences, wrote hundreds of articles blending the message of Judaism and Christianity, and serving as a missionary and administrator for Chosen People Ministries for close to 40 years. Dan's heart was dedicated 100 percent in winning people to the Messiah making it his fervent life's work for 75 years.

Dan's family has given the family of Lowe-Neddo Funeral Home the privilege of caring for him and for them. Services honoring his life, love and blessing will be held at 10 AM on Thursday, November 2, 2023, at The Haven at Highland Creek, 5920 McChesney Drive, Charlotte, NC 28269. Following the service, the family will hold a reception there beginning at 11 AM. After the reception, all are invited to make their way to Charlotte Memorial Gardens, 7632 Hood Road, Charlotte, NC 28215 for a graveside service to be held at 1 PM.
