December 16, 1935 - June 23, 2022

Daniel Penado Cisneros, 86, de Charlotte, NC, murió el Jueves 23 de Junio, 2022, en el centro médico de Novant Matthews.

Daniel nació el 16 de diciembre de 1935, en Jucuaran, El Salvador. Hijo de Reyes y Dionicia Romero Cisneros. Creció trabajando en la agricultura. En 1958, se casó con Adela Álvarez, y fueron bendecidos con 11 hijos. En el 2009, se mudaron permanentemente a Carolina del Norte. Tenía un gran talento en la música, y le encantaba enseñar a tocar instrumentos musicales, incluyendo a su propia familia. Era un excelente guitarrista, y tocaba diferentes instrumentos. Daniel era un gran hombre de Fe. Guió a muchos como maestro de Formación de Fe en la iglesia católica “El Calvario” en El Salvador. También fue parte del ministerio de la Legión de María en la iglesia católica “St John Neumann” en Charlotte, Carolina del Norte. Daniel se llenó de orgullo al ver como uno de sus jóvenes estudiantes en la catequesis, se convirtió en sacerdote y años después celebró su aniversario de bodas número 50 junto a su amada esposa Adela. Daniel was also a man of faith, and he was involved with Faith Formation with his church family at Calvary Catholic Church in El Salvador as well as a member of the Legions of Mary at St John Neumann Catholic Church in Charlotte. Daniel was very proud of the fact that

a young man who he taught as a catechist went into the ministry and returned to Daniel's life to celebrate Daniel and Adela's 50th wedding anniversary with a special Mass. Daniel's love for his wife and marriage also led him to counsel many couples in marriage planning before they received that sacrament themselves. His family counts among the greatest blessings he left to be a love of music and a love of the Lord.

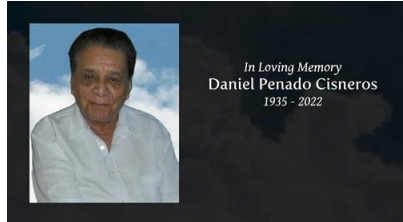
