David Norman Ramsey, 68, of Charlotte, passed away peacefully at his home on May 17, 2026. Born in Charlotte on July 25, 1957, David was the son of Robert and Joann Deese Ramsey and grew up in the community he would always call home.

From an early age, David's life was shaped by music. It was his language, his joy, and the place where he felt most himself. A gifted guitarist and drummer, he played in bands throughout his life, always happiest with an instrument in his hands and a good song in the air. He was a devoted fan of The Beatles, whose harmonies and spirit stayed with him across the decades. His musical tastes stretched wide across the rock landscape—70's rock, Ozzy Osbourne, Led Zeppelin, Pink Floyd—artists whose soundtracks became woven into the rhythm of his days. Whether he was playing, listening, or sharing a favorite track with someone he loved, music was the heartbeat of who he was.

David worked in several roles over the years, each one connecting him with people and stories he carried with him. He spent time at Coco Prints, served as a security guard at the Myrtle Beach Yacht Club, and most recently worked security at Sumpter's Jewelry on Wilkinson Boulevard in Charlotte.

Outside of music, David enjoyed the thrill of sports and racing. He was a proud Dallas Cowboys fan, a loyal admirer of Dale Earnhardt, and someone

who never missed the excitement of NASCAR. These passions brought him joy, camaraderie, and countless good memories.

A man of deep conviction, David was a proud Catholic. He converted to the faith later in life and was brought into the Church at St. John Neumann, a moment he cherished and carried with gratitude.

David is survived by his son, Bryan Scott (Michelle) Ramsey; his siblings Michael Ramsey and Susan (Kevin) Owens; and the mother of his son, Judith Carney. He is further survived by numerous relatives and friends who will remember his humor, his stories, and the soundtrack he brought into their lives. He was preceded in death by his parents.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 AM on Tuesday, May 26, in the chapel of the funeral home at 4715 Margaret Wallace Road, Matthews, NC 28105.

David's life was a song—sometimes loud, sometimes gentle, always full of heart. Those who loved him will continue to hear its echo.
