Dennis Larmer, 65, of Charlotte, North Carolina crossed the golden bridge in the early morning on February 8, 2022.

Dennis was born March 2, 1956 in Syracuse, New York, the son of Carlton and Audrey Larmer. He answered his country's call to service and faithfully served in the United States Navy. Following his honorable discharge, Dennis helped build many of the buildings around downtown Syracuse and downtown Charlotte during his career in construction work and he was very vocal about which buildings he had a part in. 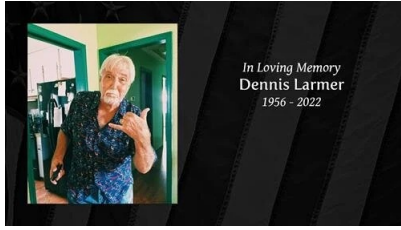
