Sassy would wait for Doris to come out of her room in the mornings and immediately jump on the walker for a ride to the living room. Doris had a strong faith, and of late often spoke of seeing her family when she passed.

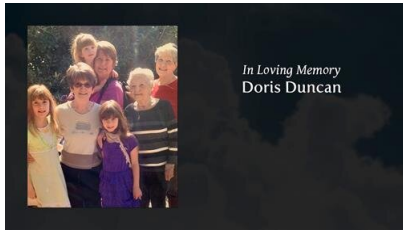
