Dorothy “Dot” Ann Baucom Penninger greeted Heaven’s Angels smiling and singing on July 3, 2017. She was born in Marshville in Union County, N.C. on August 31, 1937 to the late Henry Clayton “Shorty” Baucom and the late Annie Kate Thomas Baucom. “*Dot was my cousin. Her mother and my daddy were brother and sister. With her family living near mine, she and I spent many hours playing together. Even though she was a few years older than I, that didn't seem to matter, as far as I could tell. When my dad was having what we called the "big" chicken house built, small in comparison to the commercial chicken farms of today, she and I would find a board long enough for us each to lie on once the floor had been put into place, and then we would find some small lumber scraps. We were pretending that we were in the hospital having babies. The small pieces of wood were the babies. Of course, we did this when no work was being done on the structure being built. My favorite memory of her is this one: The summer before I began school, she used a twig to teach me my ABC's in the fine dust at the end of the driveway near the main road that belonged to an old house, which we called "the Lucy House," a run-down old house between my home and hers. That helped set the course for my education and my 30-year career as a teacher. Also, she was also intrigued by the little cavities in that same dust, where she said doodle bugs lived. She would use a twig to stir around in the little cavities hoping to find a doodle bug. I don't ever remember seeing a doodle bug. I am eternally grateful for the impact Dot had on my life.*
