Douglas Miller, 31, of Charlotte and formerly of Hillsville, Virginia, died unexpectedly at his home in Charlotte on Sunday, October 15, 2023.

Doug was born at the Womack Medical Center in Fort Bragg (now Fort Liberty), NC, on January 30, 1992, the son of Keith and Katrina Rigney Miller. He grew up in Carroll County and graduated from Carroll County High School with the Class of 2010, a straight A honor student as well as a trumpet player in the Marching Band.
