Earleen M. Mobley, 76, of Charlotte, NC passed away from ovarian cancer at her home on Friday, August 25, 2023. She was born in Charlotte, to Mozelle Yandle and Richard Earl Mabry. Earleen graduated from Garringer High School, received her BA and MA from University of North Carolina Charlotte (UNCC) in 1968. In the year before she graduated from college, she was crowned Miss UNCC and the Christmas Queen. As she got older, she spent most of her working career in the legal side of the banking industry. She retired from the legal department of Bank of America where she worked with many wonderful people.
