Effie Ruth was born in Indiana, Pennsylvania, on July 18, 1924, the daughter of Camie Jule Plubell and Effie Jane (Brady) Plubell. She was youngest of 11 children. She graduated from Indiana area high school. Growing up in a large family during the depression years, she loved to sing with her sisters and she was blessed with a lovely voice. She married Herbert R. Milligan, on August 4, 1951. They were blessed with two daughters, Jenel and Janis. They began their married life in Reynoldsville, PA, later moving to Cleveland Hts., Ohio in 1966, back to PA briefly in 1972., They lived in Jacksonville, FL, from 1972 to 1998 . Effie went on to work at the Naval Air Station as a cashier clerk laundry facility in Jacksonville, FL, for 14 years before moving to Charlotte, NC, to be closer to their daughter. She has thoroughly enjoyed making Carmel Hills Christian retirement Center her home for the past 20 years. Effie was always about hospitality and serving others. She would open her home to young people, friends and laboring brothers. She had a spark to her eye and a wit and humor and a memory that will not soon be forgotten.
