



Elizabeth "Lisa" Kimball

September 12, 1945 - August 17, 2017

Elizabeth (Lisa) Kimball, 71, of Charlotte, North Carolina, passed away on August 17, 2017, after an extended illness. The memorial service for Lisa is set for Saturday, September 9, 2017 at 2 PM to be held at Joy Church located at 11516 Idlewild Rd, Matthews, NC 28105. Pastor Mclean Faw of Joy Church will be officiating. Arrangements are being handled by Lowe-Neddo Funeral Home.

Lisa was born in Milford, Connecticut on September 12, 1945. She graduated from Haverhill High School and continued her education taking courses at Gallaudette University and Centralia College to become an interpreter for the deaf. Lisa was married to John Kimball on October 12, 1963 in Haverhill, Massachusetts; they were married 53 years.

Lisa spent her life working alongside her husband in Christian ministry; first and foremost as a pastor's wife. She and her husband were co-founders of Project Sunrise Ministries in Belize, Central America where they spent 25 years. She impacted those around her through loving service that included opening and running a local preschool, interpreter/teacher for the deaf, trained as 1st responders and running the local medical clinic in Belmopan, and coffee shop ministry both in Belize and in her local church here in Matthews. She enjoyed working with her hands by crafting specialized greeting cards in a ministry to the seniors and was actively involved in women's ministries.

Lisa is survived by her spouse John, her children Gwen, Christopher and Robyn, her grandchildren Lauren, Benjamin, Emily, Mackenzie, Logan and

Christian, and her two brothers, Colin and Lysle.
