Emily Jay Maxwell White of Cary, NC, a Child of God, went to be with her Lord and Savior on January 16, 2020 as a result of pancreatic cancer. She was born in Philadelphia, PA on October 3, 1941. Her parents were Edward Garrott Staley Maxwell, Sr. and Emily Eldredge Maxwell, both deceased. She was also predeceased by her only sibling, brother Edward Garrott Staley Maxwell, Jr.

Emily grew up in mainline Philadelphia. She was confirmed in the Episcopal Church and was a graduate of Upper Darby High School. She majored in economics at Sweet Briar College in Virginia and worked for more than 40 years in residential real estate and commercial insurance.
