



## Frank Salvatore Ingrassia

October 20, 1929 - July 18, 2014

Frank Salvator Ingrassia, 84, of Charlotte, under the care of Levine and Dickson Hospice House of Huntersville, joined his Lord and Savior on Friday, July 18, 2014.

Frank was born in Brooklyn, New York, on October 20, 1929, the son of Salvatore Frank and Augustine (nee Bica) Ingrassia. On September 1, 1951, in New York, he married Vivian Schlatter. When his country called upon him for service, he faithfully served in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict. He attended Pace University where he obtained his degree in Accounting. In 1998, he and his wife moved to Charlotte before leaving in 2004 for West Palm Beach, Florida, or "Little New York" as they called it. In January of 2014, they returned to Charlotte where he would spend his final time.

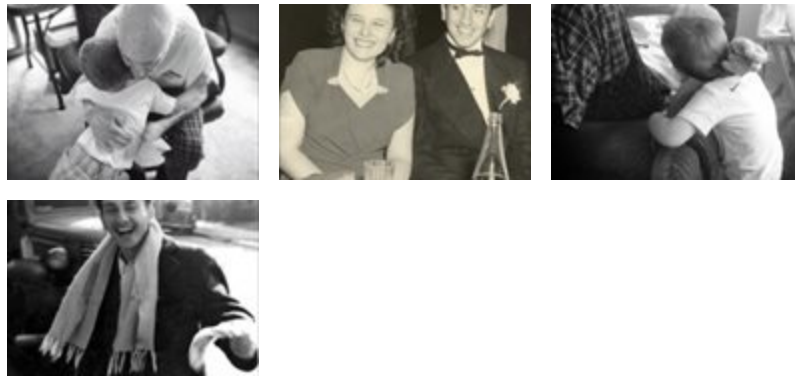
