Frieda Lucille Powell passed away peacefully on Sunday June 14th in Matthews North Carolina at the age of 91. She was born August 17, 1923 in Sheffield Vermont the second daughter of Delmer and Dora Adell (Davis) Boardman. Her early life was spent in Lyndonville and she graduated from Lyndon Institute in 1941. On December 17, 1943 she married Carlos G. Powell and they had 2 children Alice A. (Powell) Peck and Charles W. Powell. She and Carlos were both employed for 27 years by the Vermont Department of Forest and Parks as rangers serving at Darling State Park in East Burke, Smugglers's Notch State Park in Stowe and Lake Bomoseen State park in West Castleton. They retired in 1982 and spent summers in East Burke and winters in Bushnell, Florida. She was a member of the Eastern Star and enjoyed making hand-made quilts for her children and great-grandchildren.

Frieda was survived by her daughter Alice and her husband Gregory Peck of Matthews, NC and by her son Charles of Portland Maine, her granddaughter Samantha Lamb and husband Aubrey of Madison VA, and her grandson Sean Peck and his wife Holly who live in Indian Trail NC. She was the proud Great Gram to Tyler Parker in Fromberg MT, Amanda Parker from Summerduck VA, Hayley, Kiersten, Madysen and Gavin Peck in Indian Trail NC and Victoria Lamb of Madison VA.
