Gwendolyn D'Eunice Griffith, affectionately known as "Eunice" or "Gwen" was born in Barbados on November 6, 1922. She was the fourth of five children: Rita, Urban, Oscar, Gwendolyn and Verona. Her mother was Ketura Griffith and her father was David Cummings. She was educated in the Barbados Public School system.

Several years after the completion of her schooling, she began a career as a seamstress. Over the years, Gwen became known for her high quality workmanship and her services were in great demand - especially for wedding gowns and bridesmaid's dresses. She employed several assistants and churned out clothing for as much as it was in demand.

In the midst of her career, she gave birth to her only child Dennis; however, she did not allow this to slow her down. Gwen was known to work on projects even while Dennis played under the sewing machine table!

In 1978, Gwen decided to emigrate from her beloved homeland to the United States. Along with a then teen aged Dennis, she joined her sister Verona in Brooklyn, NY. In New York she embarked on a new career, becoming a Home Healthcare Facilitator. Her compassionate and caring personality made her a perfect fit for this profession. She was adored by all her clients. She remained in healthcare until retiring in 2001.

In 2003, she and Verona both moved to the Dorchester Active Adult Community in Pineville, North Carolina. While at the Dorchester, she enjoyed an active lifestyle including travelling and participation in the church chorus

and bible study. She resided at the Dorchester until her sudden passing on October 2, 2012.
