Jack Campbell Ewing, 25, of Charlotte, passed away unexpectedly on December 1, 2025. Born in Charlotte to Kristopher Ewing and Rebecca McAllister on October 9, 2000, Jack lived a life filled with laughter, friendship, and a love for sports and creativity. It all started being raised in a family where humor was cherished and laughter freely shared.

Jack discovered his passion for lacrosse early, playing on both the Carmel Middle School and Myers Park High School teams. He graduated from Myers Park High School in 2018 and went on to attend Central Piedmont Community College. He served others in his church family at Hickory Grove Baptist Church as well as working as a supervisor for a landscaping company and previously working as a lifeguard at the Johnston Memorial YMCA on Davidson Street, where his humor and kindness left lasting impressions.

Known for his quick wit and ability to make others laugh, Jack brought joy to every gathering. He enjoyed skateboarding (even competing in some local tournaments), drawing, and spending time with friends and family. A devoted sports fan, he cheered faithfully for the Carolina Panthers, Tennessee Vols football (his grandfather's alma mater), and North Carolina Tar Heel basketball.

An uncanny talent that Jack had in addition to his sense of humor was his

sense of direction. Long before Google Maps came around, his stepmother Jeni would rely heavily on Google Jack to help her get around Charlotte. He not only knew where to go, he could navigate the CATS lines at the young age of only 14 to make sure he always had a ride. And if the bus wasn't running, his skateboard always was.

Jack is survived by his father, Kristopher (Jennifer Webb) Ewing; his sister, Anna Rayne Ewing; his grandfather, Edmund McAlister; his brothers, Michael McAlister Spearman and Tyler (Kara) Webb; and his uncle, David Ewing. He is further survived by numerous other relatives and friends who will forever cherish his memory.
