



## Jack Lowery

March 3, 1947 - June 21, 2023

Jack Randall Lowery, 76, of Mint Hill, passed away on Wednesday, June 21, 2023, at his home. Through the blessing of hospice, he was able to be there surrounded by family.

Jack was born in Person County, NC, on March 23, 1947, the son of Elvin and Cordie Evans Lowery. He grew up there, graduating from Bethel Hill High School. He went on to attend the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill where he attained his Bachelor's Degree in Psychology. He moved to Charlotte and worked for a time before moving back to Person County where he eventually found his calling with the United States Postal Service.
