



Jacqueline Ann Waterfall

July 1, 1938 - October 18, 2021

It is with great sadness we share Jacqueline "Jackie" Waterfall's passing on October 18, 2021, at her Charlotte, North Carolina home. She was 83.

Jackie is preceded in death by Donald "Ike" and Ida Beyer of Rockford, Illinois, and former spouse Eugene "Gene" Waterfall, Hilton Head South Carolina.

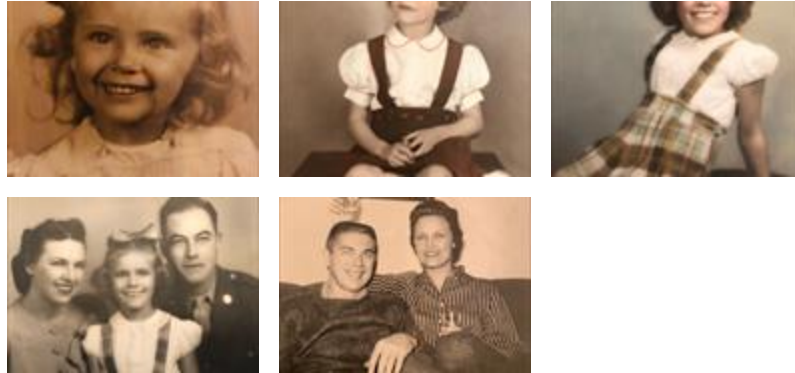

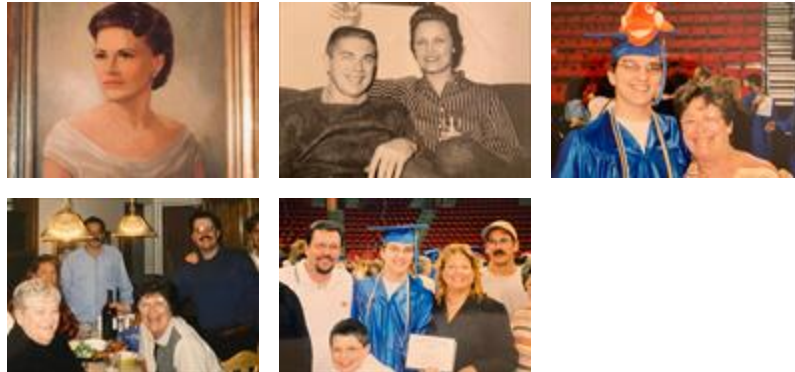
