



## James Franklin Wallace

June 1, 1943 - April 17, 2015

James “Jim” Franklin Wallace, 71, of Indian Trail, departed his earthly home for his heavenly one on Friday, April 17, 2015.

Jim was born on June 1, 1943, in Mecklenburg County, the son of Clyde and Norma Clyburn Wallace. He grew up Charlotte and graduated from Garinger High School. He went to work for Western Electric and then transferred to Southern Bell and AT&T where he worked in telecommunications until his retirement from there in 1990. On April 3, 1964, he married Carolyn Haywood at his mother’s home in Charlotte. He and his wife then opened their own business, Sundial Inc., where he continued in the telephone industry. He was proud of owning a true family business with his wife, daughter, and two sons until 2005 when the business was sold and he truly retired. Jim enjoyed gardening and fishing, but his real love was people and family, including his church family. His interests included anything his family wanted to do. All sports, including tennis and baseball, were favorites of his right along with the numerous “tea parties” that the girls wanted to have.

Jim is survived by his wife, Carolyn, of Indian Trail; four children: Linda Rape (husband James) of Indian Trail and their daughter Hannah Teal of Indian Trail; Deborah Harris (husband Tom) of Indian Trail and their children Summer Austin (husband Daniel), Christian Harris, and Elijah Harris; David Wallace (wife Angie) of Marshville and their children Savannah and Isabella; and Scott

Wallace (wife Ashley) of Monroe and their son Drake. Jim is also survived by a brother, Larry Wallace of Charlotte, and numerous other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Patsy Caston.
