Joan Marie Heuer Patterson, 82, of Mint Hill and formerly of Spokane, Washington, died Wednesday, March 30, 2016, at her daughter's home where she had been living.

Joan was born in Los Angeles, California, on September 9, 1933, the daughter of Robert Burke Heuer and Marguerite Grace Dowdall. She grew up in Los Angeles, graduated from high school and college, and attained a degree in teaching. On September 21, 1957, she married Robert Warren Patterson. Before Joan could start a career in teaching, she and Robert were blessed with five children whom Joan made caring for at home her full time profession.
