John Wayne Cox, 78, of Midland, NC, died Thursday, December 31, 2020, at Atrium Health Concord, NC.

John, or Jay as he was more commonly known, was born in Kinston, NC, on June 19, 1942, the son of John & Carrie Cox. He grew up in Kinston, at the age of 17, he moved to New Jersey to work for his uncle in the restaurant business. Jay loved spending time working on wood projects, gardening, watching old westerns and most of all playing music with his friends. Jay also loved spending time with his children and grandchildren.
