John Harrison "Harry" Jordan of Concord, died Friday, October 24, 2013, at the Northeast Medical Center in Concord at the age of 92.

Harry was born in Halifax County, NC, on July 1, 1922, the son of Samson Jordan and Annie Stegall. After high school, he faithfully served during World War II in the United States Army Air Corps from 1942 to 1945. After his military service, Harry went into the printing and paper industry first for Addressograph –Multigraph (Greensboro NC.), then as a salesman for Dillard Paper Company (Greensboro NC.), and ultimately retiring from Snyder Paper Company (Charlotte NC.) in 1986. He and his wife, Doris were faithful members of Philadelphia Presbyterian Church in Mint Hill where Harry served in the choir, as a past president of Fred Brown Sunday School, a deacon and church elder. Harry further served his community as a Mason. With a giving heart, Harry was able to do what he loved most of all, and that was serve as a husband and father. He cherished the time spent with family and friends and he will be sadly missed.
