



Joseph Louis Pallassino

July 22, 1956 - December 10, 2017

Mr. Joseph Pallassino of Charlotte, a beloved child of God, son, husband, father, brother, and uncle, went to his Heavenly Home on Sunday, December 10, 2017 due to injuries incurred in a traffic accident in Holden Beach, NC.

He was born July 22, 1956, in Nyack, NY, to parents Nicholas Joseph Pallassino and Gloria Barker and lived most of his days in New York and the Carolinas. Joseph attended Rhema Bible College in Broken Arrow, OK, where his steadfast relationship with the Lord and vibrant faith grew and developed. As a result, he led many members of his extended family to receive Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. Joseph enjoyed a long career in swimming pool installation and repair. He built an excellent reputation in the Carolinas and was loved and appreciated by his customers. Mr. Pallassino enjoyed collecting handguns, riding motorcycles, participating in events and charities with the Harley Owners Groups in both Charlotte and Shallotte, NC, reading his Bibles, and walking the beach to find the perfect shell.

Joseph is survived by his wife Joyce ("Jill") Maxwell, mother, Gloria Barker; daughters Christina Pallassino and Angela Pallassino; the mother of his children, Amy Pallassino; sister Laura Johannesen (Will), niece Kimberly McHugh (Dave), and great-niece MacKenzie McHugh, all of Charlotte. He is also survived by niece Erica Parkerson (Will), great-niece Hannah Parkerson, and great-nephew Josh Parkerson, all of Greenville, SC, as well as brother-in-

law Kip Jones (Judy), sister-in-law Carole Cornell, nieces Jennifer Zaun (Bryon); Becky Gibson (Chip), and Christine White and nephews Chet White (Alessandra) and David Cornell, all from out of state. Mr. Pallassino attended Providence Presbyterian Church and City Church, both in Charlotte, and Sharon United Methodist Church in Holden Beach, NC.

When we moved here from Michigan in 2002 we inherited our “Panther pool” (he may have mentioned our pool as it has a huge panther logo in it). My husband and I really struggled with learning how to maintain it and finding someone to repair it as we had never had a pool before. (And we were clueless). We went thru a lot of pool repair people and had a hard time finding someone who was not only fair and would show up but who also knew what he was doing. Someone finally gave us Joe’s name and from then on, we were loyal customers and gave his name out every chance we got. We were shocked to hear today about his death. I am so so sorry. I know the last few years he was starting to retire and I am so sad you lost him so early on before you could share all those days together and he could enjoy your daughters as grown up women. I am sorry we missed the funeral as I think the church is only a block away from our house in Sarah hall. Joe was always so kind to us and I chatted with him every time he came by and fixed something or helped my husband clean our filter grids or worked on a pump that of course broke right before a daughters birthday party or before relatives were coming to stay or the night before a holiday. We talked about our daughters both going to Grace Academy. We will always remember Joe for the good and loyal and hard working man he was for our family. And the reason we were able to enjoy our pool with our family for so many years and special moments like bday parties and prom and graduation parties and pictures. We truly hope he is sitting on the beach in heaven with a beautiful view (and a maintenance free pool somewhere close by). Gone too soon. Prayers for your family on this sad loss,
