Judy Williams Elwood, 75, of Charlotte, passed away from COVID 19 on Christmas Day, December 25, 2020, at Novant Health Presbyterian Campus in Charlotte.

Judy was born in Charlotte, NC, on December 15, 1945, the daughter of Olin and Mattie Baker Williams. She grew up in Charlotte, graduating from CMS. In 1977, she married Gene Elwood in York, South Carolina. Judy worked for International Paper and then Higher Right where she worked as an onsite drug screener.
