Larry Frank Manus, 69, of Indian Trail, died on his birthday, August 7, 2013, at the Hospice of Union County after a courageous battle with cancer.

Larry was born in Mecklenburg County on August 7, 1944, the son of Frank Alexander and Ella Irene (nee Baucom) Manus. In June of 1973, he met the Ms. Betty Hatley. Knowing her to be the love of his life, he married her on October 6 of that same year. Larry was a 29 year employee of Charlotte Pipe and Foundry before his health required an early retirement. When not working, he loved to paint, and was a graduate of the Bob Ross School of Painting in Tennessee and a certified trainer in the craft. His love of painting through this technique led him to teach others on it for five years. With an appreciation for music and the talent to play, Larry started playing the drums and soon was also playing the mandolin, piano, and his favorite, the bass guitar. In service to his Lord, he was a member of Wayside Baptist Church of Midland. Most of all, Larry loved his family and friends, and he will be sadly missed by them and all who knew him.

Larry is survived by his wife of almost 40 years, Betty; two sons, Terry and Jason Manus, both of Indian Trail; a grandson, Kiernan Manus; and two brothers, David (wife Teresa) Manus and Randy Manus. He is further survived by numerous nieces, nephews, other relatives, and friends. He was preceded in death by his parents; two sisters, Lois Trull and Carolyn Squires; and a brother, Roger Manus.
