



## Lawrence Richard McRae

June 27, 1933 - November 14, 2013

Lawrence Richard "Mac" McRae, 80, of Charlotte, with his family at his side, left his earthly home for the home of his Lord and Savior on Thursday, November 14, 2013, after bravely battling cancer since 2000.

Mac was born in Richmond County, NC, on Tuesday, June 27, 1933, the son of John Donald and Eva (nee Shelton) McRae. He grew up on a 190 acre farm in Ellerbe, NC, and when his country put out a call to service following World War II, Larry honorably answered. He left his trade of working in lumber and on April 6, 1953, he enlisted in the United States Army. There he completed his NCO school and was part of the Heavy Motor Co, 6th Infantry Regiment, stationed in Germany. He was honorably discharged on March 27, 1956, at the rank of Specialist and having earned the National Defense Medal, the Army of Occupation Medal, and the Good Conduct Medal.

Mac enjoyed electronics and spent his career after the military in the electronics field working for Suddreth Electronics and United Electronics. When not working, he enjoyed fishing, walking, farming, and growing Timey Toe tomatoes. Most of all, Larry loved his family and friends and the memories they made together. He will be sadly missed by all who knew him.

Mac is survived by two daughters: Beth (husband, Bill) Metzker and Beverly (husband, Bob) Combs; a sister, Earlene Blake of Ellerbe; three grandchildren: Amy, Emily, and Rachel; and three great grandchildren: Jason, Jaylen, and Natalie. Larry is further survived by numerous other family members and friends. He was preceded in death by his parents.

Mac's family has given the family of Lowe-Neddo Funeral Home the privilege of serving them during this time. Larry's family will receive friends on Monday, November 18, from 6 until time of evening services at 8 PM at the funeral home, 4715 Margaret Wallace Road, Matthews, NC 28105.
