



Leonita Hinton Marion

February 20, 1924 - August 8, 2013

Leonita Hinton Marion died August 8, 2013 at her home in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Leonita was born to Aro Goodrum Hinton and Emma Hayes Hinton on February 20, 1924. She graduated from Petroleum High School and attended Western Kentucky University for 2 years.

She married the late Carl Marion in September 1945. In 1956 the couple opened Scottsville Auto Parts, where Leonita was the bookkeeper and chief financial officer for the 27 years they owned the business.

Leonita was an active member of Mount Pleasant United Methodist Church and, in more recent years, First United Methodist Church in Scottsville. She was a charter member of the Twilighters Homemakers, and also active in the Scottsville Garden Club, the Allen County Historical Society, The Arts Council, and Daughters of the American Revolution.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Carl Marion, and her two sisters, Leona Hinton Barber and Ovaleta Hinton Haven.

Leonita is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Carol Ann and David Trent, of Charlotte NC; three granddaughters, Kathryn Trent Brown of

Fayetteville NC, and Elizabeth Marie Trent of Granada Spain, Kelly Jean Scherrer of Havelock NC; and 3 great grandchildren, Ezekiel Trent Brown, Zipporah Ruth Anne Brown, and Omari Aric Scherrer; along with 6 nieces and nephews, and many others who call her, Aunt Leonita or "Grandmother".
