



## Lincoln Wright

May 24, 1960 - June 25, 2025

Lincoln Wright, 65, a devoted father, grandfather, brother, and friend, passed away peacefully in Charlotte, North Carolina, leaving behind a legacy of quiet strength, enduring love, and unwavering loyalty.

Born in Jamaica, West Indies, on May 24, 1960, Lincoln was the son of Ezrie and Gloria Wright. His family migrated to the United States in 1970, in pursuit of better opportunities. He carried the warmth and resilience of his island roots throughout his life. He began that journey in New York, where he built a 30+ year career with Citigroup starting as a bank teller then working his way up to becoming a small business loan officer—a role in which he served with integrity, diligence, and a deep sense of responsibility to his family.

Lincoln was married to the love of his life, Annette Wright, who preceded him in death. Their bond was one of deep companionship and shared dreams, and her memory remained a guiding light in his later years.

A passionate sports fan, Lincoln was a lifelong supporter of the New York Knicks and the New York Jets. Whether celebrating a rare win or enduring a tough season, he remained loyal—an emblem of his steadfast nature.

About three years ago, Lincoln relocated to Charlotte, North Carolina, where he spent his final years surrounded by family. He is fondly remembered and dearly missed by his father; his children: Felicia (Richard) Brown of Georgia,

Cahtar (Ciani) Wright of Austin, Texas, Avery (Janae) Wright of New Jersey and Doran Wright of Staten Island, New York.

Lincoln was a proud grandfather to Faith Brown, Ramiyah Brown, Richard C. Brown, Ayden Wright, Jenin Wright, Zenna Wright, and Cahsha Wright. His grandchildren were his joy, and he cherished every moment spent with them.

He is also survived by his siblings: Lavern (Rayford) Wright Moore of Charlotte, Colene Wright of Charlotte, and Janice Annmarie Brown of California.

Lincoln's life touched many, and he is further survived by a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives, and dear friends including Tracey Easton who will remember his quiet wisdom, his warm smile, and his enduring love for family. He was preceded in death by his brother, Colin Wright and mother Gloria Wright.

Lincoln's family has given the family of Lowe-Neddo Funeral Home the privilege of caring for him and for them. Visitation will begin at 11 am on Monday, July 14, in the funeral home chapel, 4715 Margaret Wallace Road, with the service to follow at noon. 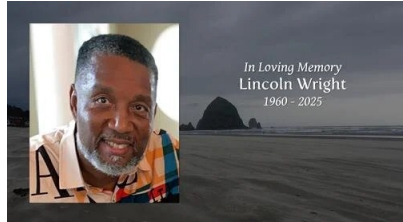
