The significant medical challenges of her birth necessitated a quick succession of major surgeries. Against all expectations, she not only survived those early weeks but began to thrive. At just weeks old, her family got the earliest indication of Linda's extraordinary tenacity for life. From her pre-school years at the Easter Seals' D.C. Society through Parkwood Elementary to Walter Johnson high School, in her long association with Fourth Presbyterian Church and her all-too-often stays in hospitals, she gathered many friends and admirers among the children, teachers, ministers, nurses, and doctors whose lives intersected hers. The family is so grateful for the support and many kindnesses shown by all to Linda over the course of her life.

Determined, impish, and remarkably positive, Linda inserted herself into life with unrelenting passion. It is Linda's magnificent strength of spirit that all of us who knew and loved her will miss the most - her belief that the set-backs and challenges that life throws in your way can only diminish you if you actually allow them to. Linda was dearly loved and will be missed very much.
