Lizeth disfrutaba cantar, cuando había eventos familiares siempre tocábamos karaoke y nunca faltaba su turno, su voz iluminaba el ánimo de todos. Siempre tan brillante y sonriente sin importar sus circunstancias. Lizeth amaba su origen y cultura, ¡pero lo que más amaba era la comida mexicana! Su plato mexicano favorito eran los chiles rellenos. Algo que Lizeth comenzaba a disfrutar era ir al gimnasio y

Lizeth enjoyed singing, when there were family events we always had karaoke playing and she never missed her turn, her voice lit up everyone's mood. Always so bright and smiling no matter her circumstances. Lizeth loved her background and culture, but what she loved the most was the Mexican food! Her favorite Mexican dish was Chiles Rellenos. Something that Lizeth was starting to enjoy was going to the gym and taking care of herself. She was so excited at how far she had gotten with her gym progress and how her hard work was starting to show. She was

looking forward to her goals and knew her hard work was paying off and continued to keep going. The gym became her safe place where she could relax and really give time for herself and nothing felt better than that.

Lizeth grew up with her mom and her younger brother Leonard Quiroz Nuñez who goes by Leodany. Along with her younger brother, she grew up with her grandparents (Pedro & Herminia Nuñez) and mom's siblings- four uncles: Daniel, Pedro, Ulises, Jonathan and five aunts: Carmen, Laura, Jimena, Angie and Julissa. Throughout the years she reconnected with her older half brother Luiz Quiroz and her older half sister Eloisa Quiroz. Luiz, who she greatly adored, was a great brother. He was very attentive to both her and Leodany and he was always there for them including important events in her life.

Lizeth had many friends but the one friend who stuck with her since middle school was Sasha, any family event Sasha was always there and it's because she quickly became part of the family. Sasha was and is an amazing and loyal friend who was by Lizeth's side no matter what. Lizeth will always be remembered by her family and friends as an amazing genuine and unique human being, someone with the purest heart and purest intentions for everybody, someone who always saw the good in everyone and never judged and was true to her word no matter what, and she always spoke her mind and that will always be something that made her one of a kind. Words will never really describe how great she was and those who really got to know her were blessed. She would be happy to see all those who loved her very much and how important she was and will be for her family and friends.
