Lois Carolyn Canup, 74, of Iron Station, NC, died unexpectedly Tuesday, December 26, 2017, at her home.

Carolyn was born in Charlotte, NC, on February 21, 1943, the daughter of Atrass Canup Sr and Lois "Dollie" Cochrane Canup. Carolyn grew up in Charlotte, graduating from East Mecklenburg High School in 1961. She went to school for Cosmetology and obtained her cosmetology license. She went onto work for Soderberg Manufacturing, then moving on to Mohican Mills when Soderberg moved their company. She spent her remaining years with Mohican Mills, eventually retiring from there at the age of 72.

Carolyn moved to Iron Station in the early 80's and had been a resident since. Carolyn enjoyed gardening and the mountains, and when indoors, could be found reading or watching Elvis and Western movies. She was a member of Faith Baptist Church in Iron Station, North Carolina. Most of all, she loved her family, especially her two grandchildren.

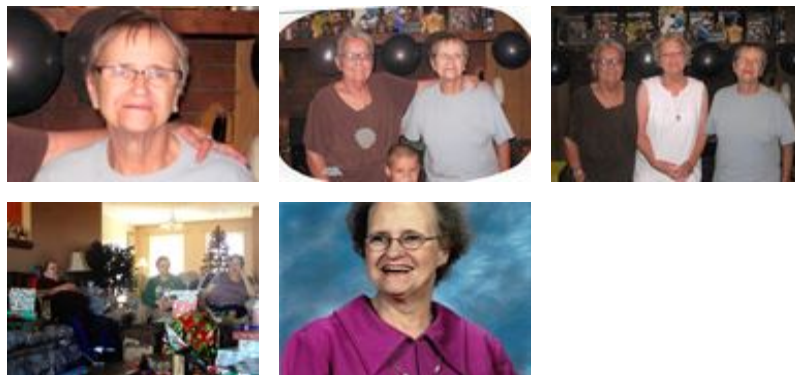
