Manning Driggers, 93, of Matthews, NC, died Monday, July 30, 2018, while under hospice care at Aldersgate Retirement Community in Charlotte.

Manning was born in Bennettsville, South Carolina, on February 17, 1925, the son of Manning P and Roxie Miller Driggers, Sr. He grew up there and when his country called on young men to enlist for WWII, he answered his country's call to service in the United States Navy. He served from 1943 until his honorable discharge in 1946. Manning went on to work for Duke Power Company, where he attained the title of manager for the Meter Department before his retirement.

Manning enjoyed many things in life. Some of his favorite things were gardening and birds, especially martins which he put out many gourd homes to draw them to his property. Most of all, he enjoyed time spent with family and friends and he will be greatly missed.

Manning is survived by his children: Delores (husband Frank) Kirkland of Indian Land, SC; Gregg (wife TinaMaria) Driggers of Charlotte, NC; and Kimberly (husband Jeff) Knell of Concord, NC. Manning is further survived by 9 grandchildren, 12 great grandchildren, 1 great great grandchild, as well as numerous other nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends. Manning was preceded in death by his parents, his siblings, and a son, Richard.
