Marilyn Louise Bittleman, 82, of Charlotte, died October 15, 2021, at Novant Health Presbyterian Campus.

Marilyn was born in Huntington, New York, on May 3, 1939, the daughter of Arthur and Louise Hoffman Blowers. She grew up there and after high school, she went into the job market. As a secretary in the shipping/receiving department of Continental Vending Machine Company, she met a manager there by the name of Harold "Hal" Bittleman Jr. They dated and on February 21, 1962, they were married at St Anthony's Catholic Church in East Northport, New York. They lived in Long Island and then Charleston, SC, before moving to Baltimore, Maryland. Eventually they moved to Charlotte in 1979. An excellent office manager, she went to work as a secretary for the Diocese of Charlotte, a position she held until her retirement. This led her to working in many churches throughout Charlotte, including Our Lady of Assumption, St John Neumann, St Patrick Cathedral, St Luke and Our Lady of Lourdes. When she was not working, she and Hal enjoyed the social clubs through the church, including Bingo and running the 50+ Club. She was also involved in the Red Hat group and the Ladies Auxiliary of the Knights of Columbus. Most of all, she enjoyed the time spent with others, especially family and friends, when she wasn't trying to keep Hal on the straight and narrow of course.

Marilyn is survived by her husband, Hal; her mother, Louise of Catskill, New York; her sisters: Cookie, Sandy and Louann. She is further survived by two

nephews, Ron and Kenneth Bittleman; and numerous other church family and friends. She was preceded in death by her father.

In honor of her faith, a Mass of Christian Burial will be held at St John Neumann Catholic Church at 11 AM on Thursday, November 4, 2021. All services will conclude at the church and a reception will follow.
