Marvin Eugene “Gene” Elwood, 74, of Charlotte, NC, died April 26, 2025, at Novant Presbyterian Hospital in Charlotte.

Gene, a lifelong resident of Charlotte, was born in Mecklenburg County on January 29, 1951, the son of Sylvester and Thelma Todd Elwood. He graduated from Harding High School, Class of 1969. Blessed with a talent for working with his hands, he ultimately worked for and retired after 34 years of faithful service as a machinist for Package Products.

When not working, Gene enjoyed many things including detailing cars. He was also a proud member of Hickory Grove Baptist Church and Masonic Lodge 715 in Derita, being inducted into the Masonic Rite in 1983.
