Melanie Lynn Haynes, 40, of Charlotte, NC, died February 6, 2021, as a result of injuries sustained after being struck by an automobile on January 27, 2021. Melanie was born in Charlotte, NC, on July 7, 1980, the daughter of Keith Haynes and Lisa Barwick. She grew up in Mint Hill and attended high school at Independence High School. 



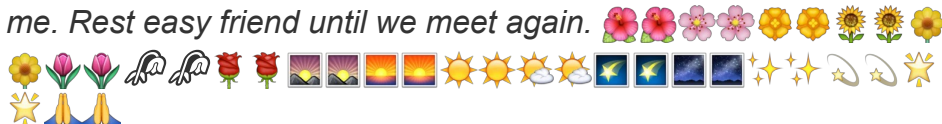
