



Melvin Baxter Porter

June 9, 1933 - October 12, 2017

Melvin “Mel” Baxter Porter, 84, of Matthews, formerly of Phoenix, Arizona, went to be with The Lord on Thursday, October 12, 2017, at Novant Medical Center in Matthews with his family at his side. Mel is survived by his loving wife of 54+ years Patricia Chaney Porter, and their children Patricia Emily Porter of Rimrock, AZ, and her fiancé Daniel Keeley, Joseph Edward Porter of Matthews, NC and his wife Patti, Jonathan Andrew Porter of Mint Hill, NC, and his wife Juliana, and Elisabeth Anne Karr of Romford, United Kingdom, and her husband James. He is also survived by his grandchildren Brian, Sean, Liam, Pierce, and Zechariah.

Mel was born in Magdalina, New Mexico to Joseph Baxter Porter and Emily Locket Gamble Porter on June 9, 1933 and was raised on his family ranch in nearby Apache Creek. In his early youth he attended Apache Creek School House, Reserve High School and the Institute of Mining and Technology, in Socorro, NM. He enlisted in the United States Army in 1953 and faithfully served until his Honorable Discharge in 1961. Soon after that, Mel met his beloved wife Patricia in Norway, where each were vacationing, and they eventually married in 1963 in Apache Creek, NM. Mel was a rancher, a truck driver for North American Van Lines and White Mountain Passenger Lines, and owned a trucking company hauling U.S. mail. His real joy was being a minister of Christ for the building up of the church. He and Patricia spent their retirement years living in Phoenix, AZ continuing to serve the Lord in the church, and spending time with his family and friends. He will be dearly

missed.
