



Mervin Charles Fox

July 16, 1937 - January 26, 2021

Mervin Charles Fox, 83, of Charlotte, died Tuesday, January 26, 2021, at Novant Health Huntersville Medical Center in Huntersville, NC.

Mervin was born in Danville, Illinois, on July 16, 1937, the son of Corbit Hayden and Ethel Mae Snyder Fox. When his country called upon him for service, he enlisted in the United States Army. Mervin earned the Good Conduct Medal and was an Expert Marksman on the Carbine and Expert Rifleman. After attaining the rank of E4, Mervin was honorably discharged August 15, 1958.

On Thanksgiving Day in 1956, he met the lovely Ms. Norma Sands, and they were married February 15, 1959, in a little country chapel on a dirt road in Illinois. After they were married, they lived in the Danville, Illinois area where Mervin worked as a foreman at an industrial manufacturing plant. In 1974, they moved to Greenville, South Carolina where he attended Bob Jones University in preparation for the ministry. In 1979 he and Norma went to the Azore Islands of Portugal where they were blessed to serve as missionaries to the Portuguese people for nearly 23 years. Mervin was also a seeder, and he planted Hispanic churches in Virginia and in Charlotte as part of his 47 years in the ministry.

When not working, Mervin enjoyed the time spent with family and friends and working around the house.

Mervin is survived by his wife of 62 years, Norma; his children: his daughter Crystal (husband Scott) Josey of Maiden, NC; a son Greg (wife Misty) Fox of Concord, NC; and a son Jim (wife Karen Melissa) Fox of Pelzer, SC; grandchildren: Ed Rodriguez, Austin Rodriguez and Amy (husband Leroy) Rodriguez Fung, Alex Fox, Cassie Rojas, Brandon Rojas, and Rachel (husband Jerem) McClendon. Grandson, Anthony Fox. He is further survived by great grandchildren: Ben and Gracelynn; his siblings: Elmer Fox, David Fox, Carl Fox and Debbie Key; as well as numerous nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends. Mervin was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers: Cecil and Larry; and a

grandson, Robert.

Mervin's family has given the family of Lowe-Neddo Funeral Home the privilege of caring for him and for them. Funeral services will be held at Bible Baptist Church, 2724 Margaret Wallace Road, Matthews, NC 28105. Visitation will begin at 11:00 AM on Thursday, February 4, with services to follow at 11:30.
