Mircha Moraru, 85, of Indian Trail, died Wednesday, November 9, 2016, at Union Point Healthcare in Monroe, NC.

Mircha was born in Chernivtsi, Ukraine, on April 26, 1931, the son of Theodore and Euphrosinya Hnatyuk Moraru. He married Anastasia Viunik and in 1992, they moved to the United States.
